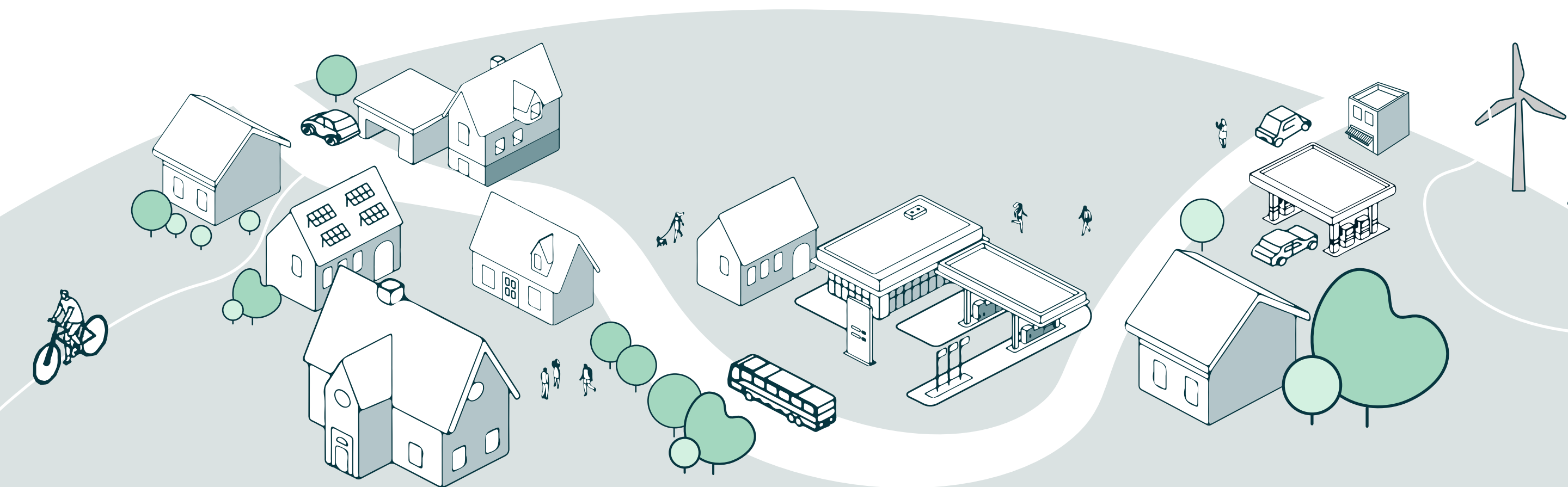


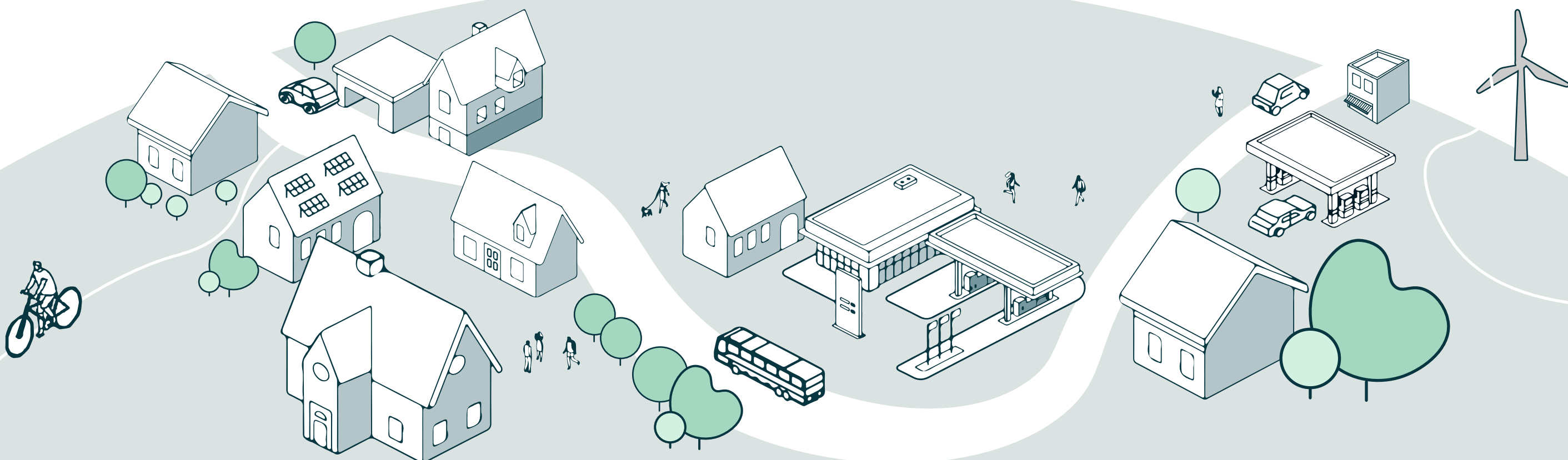

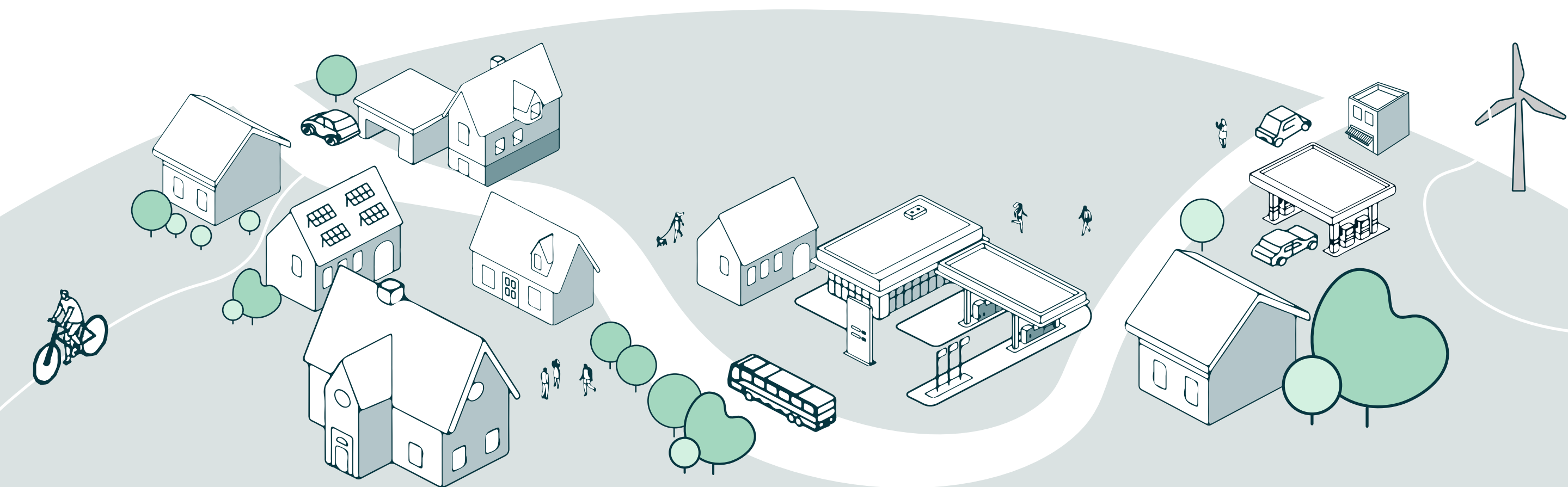

How will your organization contribute to the development/ monitoring of the four pilot demonstration projects?

Codema is leading the REGEN demo site intervention, supported by Dublin City Council (DCC) staff and the Sustainable Energy Community represented by founding member Arden Energy. The three partners are working very closely and leveraging existing relationships for successful interventions.

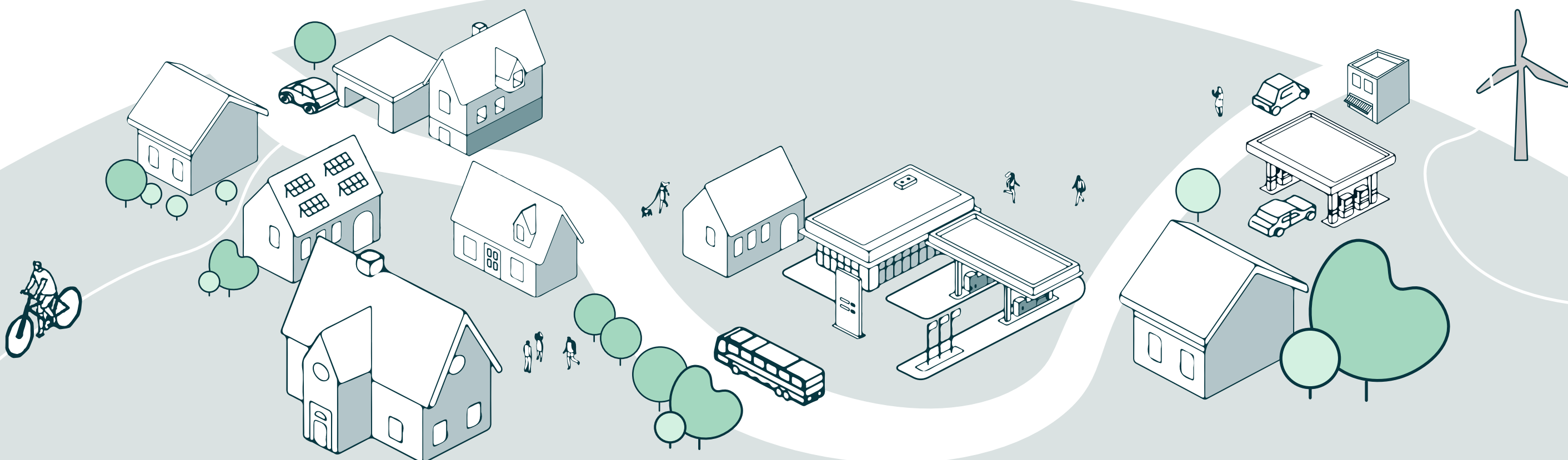
Codema, as the Dublin pilot lead, plays a key role not only in both the internal and external coordination activities of the demo, but also in bringing technical and engagement expertise to the consortium.



What role will your team play in developing strategies to improve urban planning best practices through neighbourhood regeneration interventions?

As the Dublin pilot lead, Codema will use spatial and urban planning to help prioritise projects in the demo site and, critically, decide where to place them.

Spatial planning, in the context of climate action, is a strategic approach to managing land use and development. Essentially, it means looking at the area and deciding 'what goes where' to help reach the goal of a 51% reduction in emissions by 2030 in the Dublin demo site, to minimise environmental impact, and to promote a greener, more sustainable future for the Ringsend, Poolbeg, and Irishtown pilot area.
